

Conditions of membership

1. Members are expected to volunteer to help with maintenance of the pool and the gardens and with fund raising activities. Please see the back of your membership form for more details. Committee members will ask for your help from time to time during the year.
2. Membership is open to all adults on payment of appropriate fee provided that they are prepared to comply with these conditions.
3. All members must produce a valid membership card when attending swimming sessions.
4. All members and guests must sign in the Members' Book before taking part in the swimming session. Members must sign in for their children.
5. Children under the age of 18 may not become members. They will be admitted as part of a family provided that the family subscription has been paid.
6. Parents must supervise their children's safety and behaviour at all times; there is no supervision of the learner pool, so parents must watch their children.
7. Each member may bring one adult and one child guest to any club session on the payment of the guest fee. Each guest may visit up to six times in a season.
8. Each adult member (excluding non-swimmer members) must act as Safety Supervisor a minimum of four times a season. These must include a Sunday or Bank Holiday evening session and should include a Tuesday evening session.
9. All members, when acting as Safety Supervisors, must report to the duty committee member promptly and sign a copy of the safety instructions; a copy of these is kept in the Members' Book.
10. Members, their children and guests must not cause a nuisance to other users of the pool at any time. Safety Supervisors are authorised to insist that any person causing a nuisance or disturbing others must leave.
11. Glass must not be brought onto Pool premises.
12. The Club has the right to refuse or withdraw membership.

Hampton Pool Swimming and Social Club was formed in 1985 by volunteers from the local community who had reopened the Pool for swimming following its closure by the local council.

Voluntary work is still a priority and is expected of all members!

HP Afloat offers a friendly and relaxed atmosphere with non-competitive lane swimming in a quiet environment. Part of the pool is not laned off and is suitable for swimmers who are learning or who are less confident. The Learner Pool is also open during Club sessions. On Tuesday evenings this season one lane will also be used for swimming lessons.

The self-cook barbeque can be used on **Sunday** and **Tuesday** evenings (and Bank Holiday Mondays). A swim followed by an outdoors meal overlooking Bushy Park makes a perfect end to a summer's day!

Safety

Professional lifeguards are **NOT** on duty during club sessions which are supervised by members. **MEMBERS AND GUESTS SWIM AT THEIR OWN RISK.**

All members must volunteer to work as Safety Supervisors for a minimum of four different sessions this season, including a Sunday or Bank Holiday evening. They must arrive 15 minutes before the start of sessions. The session will not open if there are fewer than three safety supervisors present.

The Season

The season runs from Saturday 3rd April until Sunday 3rd October.
