

Conditions of membership

1. Members are expected to volunteer to help with maintenance of the pool and the gardens and with fund raising activities. Committee members will ask for your help from time to time during the year.
2. Members must behave with courtesy and consideration to pool staff and other club members. Complaints should be addressed to the committee member on duty, who will ensure that information is passed on to the pool duty manager.
3. Membership is open to all adults on payment of the appropriate fee provided that they are prepared to comply with these conditions.
4. All members must present a valid membership card when attending swimming sessions.
5. Children under the age of 18 may not become members. They will be admitted as part of a family provided that the family subscription has been paid.
6. Parents must supervise their children's safety and behaviour at all times; there is no supervision of the learner pool, so parents must watch their children.
7. Each member may bring two adults and two children as guests to any club session on the payment of the guest fee. Each guest may visit up to six times in a season.
8. Each adult member (excluding non-swimmer members) must act as Safety Supervisor a minimum of four times a season. These must include a Sunday or Bank Holiday evening session and should include a Tuesday evening session.
9. All members, when acting as Safety Supervisors, must report to the duty committee member promptly.
10. Members, their children and guests must not cause a nuisance to other users of the pool at any time. Safety Supervisors are authorised to insist that any person causing a nuisance or disturbing others must leave.
11. Glass must not be brought onto Pool premises.
12. The Club has the right to refuse or withdraw membership.
13. All of the Pool rules must be adhered to at all times.

The club is designed to encourage families and other swimmers to become involved with the aims and objectives of Hampton Pool Trust – to ensure the continued viability of the pool into the future. It is not a sports club and no coaching or sport activities are offered. The club has a friendly and relaxed ambience with the accent on enjoyment. Lane swimming is available at all club sessions but there is plenty of room for families to enjoy themselves in both the main pool and the smaller teaching pool. The sessions take place outside public swimming sessions and therefore benefit from a quieter environment. During the evening sessions the BBQ is lit so that members can cook and socialise.

Originally known as the Swimming and Social Club, it has now been renamed the Poolside Swim & BBQ Club for the 2011 season. It was established in 1985 when a group of local people saved Hampton Pool from permanent closure and it became the focal point for volunteers who raised money, cleared rubble and restored the pool for use by swimmers.

The emphasis on community spirit and voluntary work remains central to the club and all members are expected to contribute by organising and participating in fund raising activities and by offering more practical help with gardening and other maintenance. This commitment is an essential element of membership.

Safety

Professional lifeguards are **NOT** on duty during club sessions which are supervised by members. **MEMBERS AND GUESTS SWIM AT THEIR OWN RISK.**

All members must volunteer to work as Safety Supervisors for a minimum of four different sessions this season, including a Sunday or Bank Holiday evening. They must arrive 15 minutes before the start of sessions. The session will not open if there are fewer than three safety supervisors present.

The Season

The club meets on four times each week from April until the beginning of October (2 April 2011 to 2 October 2011), with additional sessions on Bank Holiday Monday evenings.
