Operating from spring until autumn, we also do voluntary work for the pool, including helping at the fantastic fundraising Summer Picnic Concerts and raising awareness of the pool within the community.

However, it is not a sports club and no coaching or sport activities are offered.

## **Our story is part of the pool's history**



Originally known as the Swimming and Social Club, it was renamed the Poolside Swim & BBQ Club in 2011. It was established in 1985 when a group of local people saved Hampton Pool from permanent closure and it became the focal point for volunteers who raised money, cleared rubble and restored the pool for use by swimmers.

The emphasis on community spirit and voluntary work remains central to the club and all members are expected to contribute by organising and participating in fund raising activities and by offering more practical help with gardening and other maintenance. This commitment is an essential element of membership.

## Safety

All members must volunteer to work as poolside helpers for a morning and evening duty for a minimum of two different sessions this season. They must arrive 10 minutes before the start of sessions.

## The season

The club meets four times each week from Saturday 1 April to Saturday 30 September 2017, with additional sessions on Bank Holiday Monday evenings.

## Swimming times

There are four club sessions a week at the following times (plus 18:00–21:00 on Bank Holiday Mondays):

## Conditions of membership

1. All of the Pool rules must be adhered to at all times.
2. Members are expected to volunteer to help with maintenance of the pool and the gardens and with fund raising activities. Committee members will ask for your help from time to time during the year.
3. Members must behave with courtesy and consideration to pool staff and other club members. Complaints should be addressed to the committee member on duty, who will ensure that information is passed on to the pool duty manager.
4. Membership is open to all adults on payment of the appropriate fee provided that they are prepared to comply with these conditions.
5. All members must present a valid membership card when attending swimming sessions.
6. Children under the age of 18 may not become members. They will be admitted as part of a family provided that the family subscription has been paid. **All children under 10 MUST be accompanied by an adult IN THE WATER** (within easy reach) at all times. No more than two under 10s to each adult.
7. Parents must supervise their children's safety and behaviour at all times.
8. Each member may bring two adults and their children as guests to any club session on the payment of the guest fee. Each guest may visit up to six times in a season.
9. Each adult member (excluding social members) must act as a poolside helper a minimum of twice a season which should include one morning and one evening session.
10. Each adult member is encouraged to volunteer at a minimum of two fundraising or awareness raising events, such as the Summer Picnic Concerts.
11. All members, when acting as a poolside helper, must report to the duty committee member promptly.
12. Members, their children and guests must not cause a nuisance to other users of the pool at any time. Poolside helpers are authorised to insist that any person causing a nuisance or disturbing others must leave.
13. Glass must not be brought onto Pool premises and all areas at the pool and adjacent areas including the car park are non-smoking areas.
14. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied in the water by an adult.
15. The Club has the right to refuse or withdraw membership.
