Our story is part of the pool's history

The club was established in 1985 when a group of local people saved Hampton Pool from permanent closure and it became the focal point for volunteers who raised money and restored the pool for use by swimmers.

About the club today and our voluntary work

The club is designed to encourage families and other swimmers to become involved with the aims and objectives of Hampton Pool Trust. We also do voluntary work for the pool, including helping at the fantastic fundraising Summer Picnic Concerts and raising awareness of the pool within the community.

The emphasis on community spirit and voluntary work remains central to the club and all members are expected to contribute by organising and participating in fundraising activities and by offering more practical help with gardening and other maintenance. This commitment is an essential element of membership.

Six more reasons to join the Poolside Swim & BBQ Club:

- We welcome individuals, couples or families of whatever age;
- Our aim is to ensure the continued survival and viability of the pool by our volunteer work;
- We host a friendly and relaxed ambience with the accent on enjoyment;
- There are at least three lanes for swimming at all club sessions ...and plenty of room for families to enjoy themselves in both the main pool and the smaller learner pool;
- You can enjoy the benefits of a quieter environment *(sessions take place outside of public swimming times, although swimming lessons still take place on Saturday mornings)*
- The BBQ is lit during the evening sessions for members to cook their own food and socialise.

Safety

All sessions are lifeguarded by Hampton Pool staff but **members must volunteer as poolside helpers** for a minimum of two sessions a season.

Conditions of membership

1. All of the Pool rules must be adhered to at all times.
2. Members are expected to volunteer to help with maintenance of the pool and the gardens and with fund raising activities. Committee members will ask for your help from time to time during the year.
3. Members must behave with courtesy and consideration to pool staff, other club members and their guests. Complaints should be addressed to the committee member on duty, who will ensure that information is passed on to the pool duty manager.
4. Membership is open to all adults on payment of the appropriate fee provided that they are prepared to comply with these conditions.
5. All members must present a valid membership card when attending swimming sessions.
6. Children under the age of 18 may not become members. They will be admitted as part of a family provided that the family subscription has been paid. All children under 8 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult **IN THE WATER** (within easy reach) at all times. No more than two under 8s to each adult.
7. Parents must supervise their children's safety and behaviour at all times.
8. Each member may bring two adults and their children as guests to any club session on the payment of the guest fee. Each guest may visit up to six times in a season.
9. Each adult member (excluding social members) must act as a Poolside Swim & BBQ Club helper a minimum of twice a season which should include one morning and one evening session.
10. Each adult member is encouraged to volunteer at a minimum of two fundraising or awareness raising events, such as the Summer Picnic Concerts.
11. All members, when acting as a poolside helper, must report to the duty committee member 10 minutes before each session.
12. Members, their children and guests must not cause a nuisance to other users of the pool (and surrounding grounds), pool staff or Trust members during club sessions. Poolside & BBQ Club helpers are authorised to insist that any person causing a nuisance or disturbing others must leave and this may result in loss of membership (see condition 15).
13. Glass must not be brought onto Pool premises and all areas at the pool and adjacent areas including the car park are non-smoking areas.
14. You approve to your data being shared with the club committee.
15. The Club has the right to refuse or withdraw membership.
